Risk of prostate cancer. About 1 man in 9 will be diagnosed with prostate cancer during his lifetime. Prostate cancer is more likely to develop in older men and in African-American men. About 6 cases in 10 are diagnosed in men who are 65 or older, and it is rare in men under 40. The average age at diagnosis is about 66.

A clinical stage of the prostate tumor that is felt by digital rectal exam extending across the midline of the gland i.e., stage T2b. Any cancer detected on a scan outside the prostate including the pelvic lymph nodes, but no cancer that has spread further beyond the pelvic lymph nodes.
